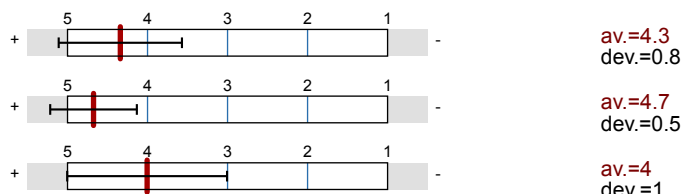

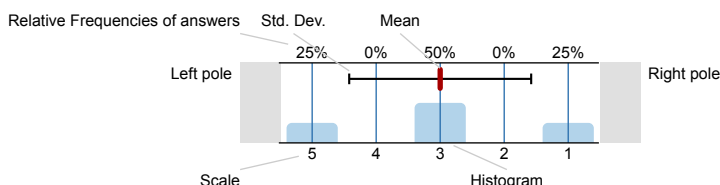
Class/Seminar Teacher Evaluation (Scale width: 5)

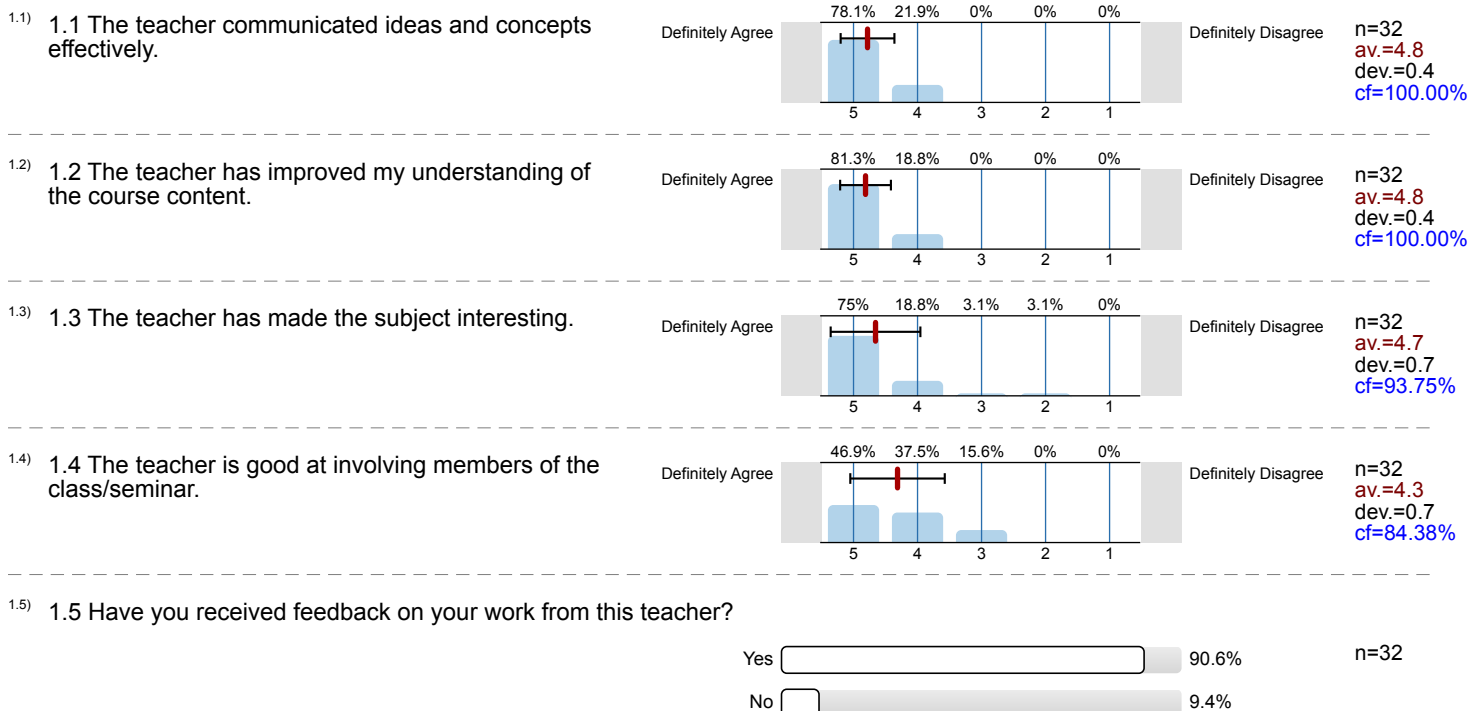

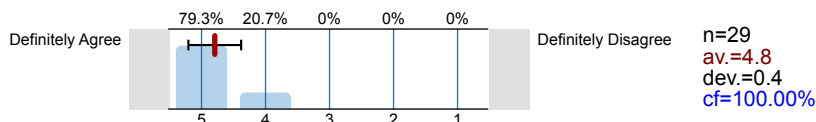

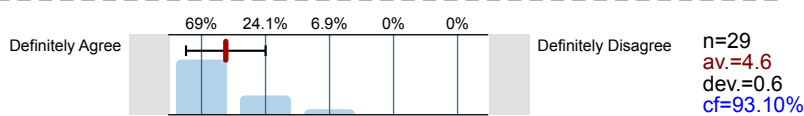

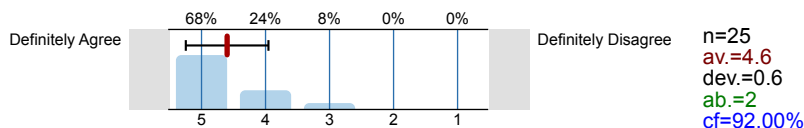

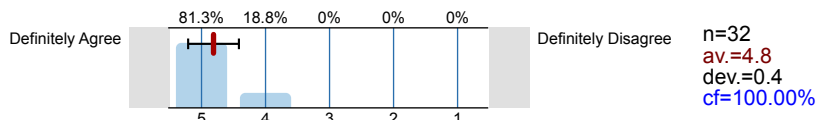
